INTERNET SIGHTINGS

Internet Sightings by Jim Hawes

This column highlights some of the more notable recent internet notices, newsletters and blogs dealing with IP prosecution issues.

- The 10/6/10 newsletter says that the PTO is on track to issue a record number of patents this year.
 - The 10/12/10 email reports that the Supreme Court has granted cert in the Global-Tech case to consider the “deliberate indifference” standard for patent infringement.
 - The 10/14/10 report discusses the Costco case now before the Supreme Court for its IP rights exhaustion issues.
 - The 10/15/10 newsletter discusses the PTO FY2010 partial report, noting that total pendency is somewhere in the 5 to 7 year range, due in large part to “application churning.”
- The 10/29/10 email reports that the DOJ has flunked Patents 101 for its patentability of DNA brief relying on the Funk decision.

Patently-O – a blog written by Dennis Crouch – www.patentlyo.com.

- The 10/4/10 email cites the Chippendale CAFC decision, holding the cuff and collar trade dress to not be registrable as inherently distinctive based on the 4 Seabrook factors, in spite of having been previously registered based on acquired distinctiveness.
 - On 10/5/10 Dennis and others announced that they were circulating a paper reviewing all the CAFC's decisions on inequitable conduct.
 - The 10/9/10 blog gives allowances per examiner data for FY 2001 to 2010.
 - The 10/12/10 email cites and discusses three recent BPAI §101 cases.
 - The 10/25/10 message reports that petitions work. 78% were granted. Of the rest, 20% were first denied then, on reconsideration, were granted. Much more was reported – check it out.
- The 10/30/10 email reports that the DOJ supports the DC holding that isolated genes are unpatentable. Oh, oh.

USPTO – The official website of the Office – uspto.gov.

- The Office continues to expand use of the Patent Prosecution Highway. The 3 newest members are Spain, Austria and Russia.
- As a reminder, on 7/27/10 the USPTO published interim guidelines for examiners considering Bilski §101 issues.
- The PTO also has announced that the first action interview pilot program has been extended to 4/1/11.
- On 10/20/10 the PTO and the EPO announced a joint project to develop a patent classification system.
- The PTO has been advised by WIPO that, due to currency fluctuations, the fees involving US cases were changed 11/1/10.
- The Commerce Dept. is reported to be seriously considering satellite offices for the PTO. Some cities are said to be lobbying.
- The PTO and the IPO are co-sponsoring a PTO Day conference in DC on 12/6/10.

Other Stuff –

- ACI is holding a Biotech Patents conference in Boston on 11/30-12/1.
 - The 2010 IP Yearbook has been published by the Midwest IP Institute. Its 13 chapter titles are listed in the 10/7/10 TTABlog. The 10/8/10 TTABlog offers it at a 10% discount.
- The IQPC will hold its 6th annual patent conference on developing IP strategies in London 12/7-8/10.
