INTERNET SIGHTINGS

This column highlights some of the more notable recent internet notices, newsletters and blogs dealing with IP prosecution issues.

The 9/1/10 newsletter reports that Lynne Beresford has been reappointed Commissioner of Trademarks for a term ending in August 2015. About time.

On 9/1/10 the PTO announced implementation of the new 24 month provisional application practice on a trial basis. See Hal's analysis.

The 9/15/10 post reports that the top patent filings for '08 were` China (980K), Japan (390K), US (290K), Korea (240K) and Taiwan (110K).

Patently-O – a blog written by Dennis Crouch – www.patentlyo.com.

The 9/3/10 blog reports that the PTO has issued an updated 18pp. guideline for determining obviousness. Check the PTO website.

The 9/4/10 email gives current data on BPAI backlog and decisions. The average time now from appeal to decision is 29 months. Ugh.

The 9/13/10 post reports the American Medical Systems CAFC decision and the proper construction of a claim preamble.

Another 9/13/10 post (re. compact prosecution) includes a comment asserting that nearly 1/3 of solo patent attys. are 60 or older.

A 9/14/10 email discusses the Tri-Star Electronics CAFC decision holding an assignment to a defunct corp. employer valid to transfer title to a successor corporation.

The 9/29/10 blog discusses patent term adjustment when a rejection is withdrawn following filing of the appeal brief.

Carl Oppedahl – emails of PCT practice matters: oppedahl.com/pct.

The Oppedahl firm offers free audio lectures on various aspects of patent practice tied to old patent bar exam questions.

The 9/17/10 email points out that the wording in PTO forms tends to lag behind practice developments, so don't take them literally.

The 9/22/10 note discusses and compares the five searching authorities available to US applicants, including their fees.

The 9/25/10 message presents considerations relevant to selecting a search and examination authority.

The 9/27/10 email set forth much useful PCT information including the limitations on amendments in a "Highway" case.

Patent Docs – focusing on biotech and pharma patent issues – see patentdocs.org

Beginning last month the PTO will now accept interviews by those filing an Applicant Initiated Interview Request Form.

The 9/16/10 doc reports that the PTO has begun a patent examiner technical training program using outside lecturers.

The 9/28/10 doc reports that WIPO has launched an online compilation of national IP laws and treaties.

IPWatchdog – a patents and patent law blog – watchdog.com.

The 9/15/10 blog found from a recent study that PTO disciplinary actions don't lead, but just follow, state actions.

TTABlog – a blog written by John Welch – www.TTABlog.com

The 9/9/10 blog reports that the mark "Corporate Fuel" was approved for registration by the TTAB without disclaimer of "Corporate," the mark being a unitary phrase.

The 9/15/10 email reports that two new judges have joined the TTAB, bringing the total to 19 judges.
